# The Most Holy Trinity 26<sup>th</sup> May 2024 - Year B

Dear Parishioners,

We have begun our Feastival season with the celebration of The Most Holy Trinity, patron of our Banyo church. The Banyo community will mark the occasion by processing the flags of the different ethnicities that comprise the people of our Parish family. I intend to modify the process of welcoming and processing the various national flags this year from the methodology employed in 2023, my first year of the Parish's Feastival. This year, I will process into the church in the usual fashion, and after the Sign of the Cross, and a few words of introduction, I will call on those who will be processing their national flags one-by-one into the church to do so and to place their flag on the sanctuary floor before the Altar, and to do so in an orderly fashion. I will also ask them to announce to the assembled Parishioners, the name of their country, before they place their flag on the sanctuary floor. This amended process will assist the assembled people to appreciate more fully the universality of the Church.

Next Sunday will be the patronal feast of our Nundah church. And it will be marked by our Corpus Christi Street Procession. It is important that our procession forms up in our church carpark in readiness for our 11:00am start. Eva Cusack and Anna Gomes have volunteered their services to form the walkers in your disparate groups of interest (e.g. Laudate si, Care and Concern, SVDP Conferences, Youth Group, and so on). I would ask for a cooperative spirit to prevail in heeding and obeying the two women. The Parish has prepared an order of procession so that people can find their way quickly to their desired group. Catholics from our neighbouring Deanery Parishes and the Holy Spirit Seminary have been invited to join our Procession too, and since I don't know for sure about who might be attending from these Parishes, we need to accommodate for them too.

Now, I'm well aware that not all our Parishioners will be able to participate by marching in our Corpus Christi Procession, so I am suggesting that those who are unable to march might care to come over to the Parish Centre and sit comfortably out on the patio to see us off and to watch us return back to the church carpark. The Parish Centre will be opened during the Procession for this purpose. Then, once the Procession is back, you could participate in the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction too.

Throughout the Procession, the Holy Rosary will be prayed, so please join in those prayers.

Today also marks the conclusion of National Volunteers week (May 20-26). The ratio of people serving in a volunteer capacity both within our Parish (in various ministries) and the broader community is quite remarkable. I really don't know the per capita ratio of volunteers per 100,000 of the Australians is, perhaps the Australian Bureau of Statistics would have that data, but I would surmise that it would be very low (e.g. 1:10,000), however, in our Parish setting, the per capita ratio of those serving our Parish community as volunteers, I suggest would be something in the order of 20:100. It might actually be even higher. The point that I am trying to stress is that we, the Parishioners of Banyo Nundah Parish, actually owe a huge debt of gratitude to all who serve our Parish community as volunteers, and I should like to recognise this by saying 'Thank You' to you all. Your service to your brothers and sisters in Christ helps to make our Parish function better and attests to your generosity of spirit. So, thank you!
