Dear Parishioners,

A dear Parishioner was called to God last Saturday night; he was John Francis Carr. John had a long association with the Nundah Parish before the amalgamation of Banyo and Nundah and he continued his association with the expanded Parish in a number of capacities: as a Reader, Communion Minister and a Choir Member, as a Parish Finance Councillor, and as the Convenor of the *Parish Computer Project* (something that was near and dear to his heart that he implemented in 2006). Our hearts go out to his wife, Sue, and her family at this time. John's Funeral Mass will be celebrated in the Corpus Christi Church tomorrow (Monday) from 11:00am. Please remember John in your prayers.

No one can doubt that our Parish has had an intensive start to the 2024 year. We're almost at mid-year, and already we have achieved a mountain of work. Some examples of this are:

- The completion of our first round of the RCIA program during which we received three new members into our Parish family.
- The completion of the Parish Confirmation program and the celebration of that Sacrament.
- The commencement of preparations for our continuation of Parish Sacramental Program with the Sacraments of Penance and First Eucharist for which the Parents Enquiry sessions occur on Wednesday (7:00pm Banyo) and Thursday (3:30pm Nundah) of this week.
- The celebration of our annual Festival – the Octave of our two Patronal Feast Days – The Most Holy Trinity and The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi).
- The celebration of our first Corpus Christi Street Procession and its associated liturgical rites.
- The commencement of our second round of the RCIA with its four Catechumens and one Candidate (five in total) – we're almost at the mid-point of the program.
- The completion of the Parish's Safeguarding Audit.
- The celebration of Opening School Masses for both Parish Primary Schools.
- The visitation and meeting with Primary School Classes for both Schools.
- The celebration of our Lenten and Easter Seasons with its attendant Ash Wednesday and Holy Week liturgies.
- The celebration of our Parish ANZAC Day Mass and Parish participation at the Banyo and Nundah ANZAC Day Marches.
- The celebration of monthly Masses at the Mercy Aged Care and Zion Aged Care centres.
- The celebration of Anointing Masses in both Parish Churches.
- Attendance and participation at numerous PPC, PFC and Liturgy Committee meetings.

These are only a snapshot of the activities that occur within our Parish.

But there has been one other important matter that hasn't been attended to before now because of the busyness of our Parish and because I didn't want to overwhelm Parishioners, and it has to do with the annual Election of Councillors to the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC).

There have been three resignations from the PPC this year, and their retirements were acknowledged in earlier Newsletter Messages. The resultant vacancies were left unfilled both because our mid-year PPC Elections were so close and also the intensity of our Parish activities. It is now time to attend to and fill those vacancies. Your PPC is now calling for expressions of interest and/or nominations (N.B. I would accept self-nominations too) to close on Sunday, 30 June 2024. The A5 PPC Nomination Form and Special Envelopes have been put out on the tables near the front doors of both Parish churches and on the front counter of the Parish Centre for Parishioners to take. The PPC Nomination Form is a double-sided affair; one side has information about the ambit and central role of what a PPC plays in the life of a Parish, the other side is the Nomination Form itself. If you take a Nomination Form, please also collect a Special Envelope at the same time. Please seal your nomination form in the Special Envelope and either place the Envelopes in one of the Sunday Mass Collections between now and final Sunday of June, or, alternatively, return the Envelope direct to the Parish Centre. I urge Parishioners to seriously consider serving your fellow Parishioners in this important and essential ministry, and not to quickly dismiss the opportunity to serve others by thinking that 'I'll leave it to someone else', with the result that we don't fill all the vacancies.

Finally, I just want to bring to your attention that our Parish will be hosting a Peter Kearney Concert and Reflection event called 'Signs of Hope – People of Faith' in our Banyo Church, on Saturday, 20 July, from 11:30am. Space does not permit a more detailed explanation of the event, but you can ascertain that information yourself by looking at the advertising posters in our churches or on page three of this newsletter.
