Dear Parishioners,

A number of children in our Parish have been enrolled by their parents during the past week to participate in our second and final children's sacramental program; this time the Sacraments will be Penance and Eucharist. The children will actually commence the program once school resumes in the next school semester (i.e. the weekend of the 13th and 14th of July). I would ask for your prayerful of these Candidates until they finish their journey of initiation into the Church in late August.

The other major sacramental program that is current is our Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). A brief progress report. Our four Catechumens (soon to be Elect) and our sole Candidate have passed the midpoint in their preparation. Together, the RCIA team (which includes Catechists, Sponsors and the five Candidates) have met on seven occasions, six more meetings remain. The next critical point in their life-changing experience will be their enrolment in the Book of the Elect; this will occur on Sunday, July 7, during the 9:30am Mass. Again, just like I have requested your prayerful support for the children in the Sacramental Program (in the previous paragraph), please keep these five RCIA Candidates in your prayers too. Their planned date of reception into the Catholic Church will be Sunday, 25 August.

The end of the financial year (EOFY) will soon be upon us. Coinciding with the EOFY is the Parish's issuing of boxes of new Planned Giving (PG) Envelopes for those who have opted to continue using them as a means of financially supporting the pastoral work of the Parish. The boxes are ready for collection this weekend. So, if you are a PG Envelope contributor, please check for and collect your box of Envelopes this weekend.

The school mid-year vacation has begun again, it effectively started on Friday afternoon. Once again, I issue my general warning to everyone to be careful whenever and wherever you take to the roads during the next fortnight. Road traffic always intensifies whenever school vacations occur, so please drive carefully and safely come back home to us, if you are travelling anywhere.

Last weekend, I began our 2024 campaign to fill vacant positions of the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC). I was delighted to see a good number of Parishioners collect and take away with them, the A5 size PPC dual information sheet and nomination form. I hope for our Parish's sake, that with so many taking home that form, that it will translate into a bumper crop of nominations being received. Seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit as you discern whether this is a ministry that you can participate in, and if you can (and I hope that you will do so), please complete the nomination form, stick it inside the PPC Nominations envelope, and either place it on one of the Mass Collection baskets, or give it to me personally, or drop it in to the Parish Office no later than 30 June. Thank you!

Catholic Foundations Course: 'A People on Mission'


