Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 30th June 2024 - Year B

Dear Parishioners,

The Solemnity Feast of Sts Peter and Paul occurred yesterday (Saturday, June 29). The Feast is a significant event in the life of our Archdiocese specifically, but also for our Church as a whole. June 29th has been the traditional day for many of our clergy as the day of their ordination to the priesthood. Currently, there are 38 Archdiocesan priests ordained on June 29th, but I'm not one of them. My ordination date was July 5th, and I will be celebrating my 22nd anniversary on Friday. On the days either side of June 29th, are the anniversaries of other priests: there are 4 on June 27th, 3 on June 28th, 4 on June 30th, and 2 on July 1st. My predecessor, Fr Bernie Gallagher, was ordained in that last group. Many of our deceased priests were ordained on June 29th too. That's the significant event for the Archdiocese. But what about the Church?

The Solemnity Feast of Sts Peter and Paul is also the time when Catholics are called upon to consider financially helping the poor around the globe. The Church does this through the Annual Peter's Pence Collections that are taken up on the Feast Day. Our Archdiocese has decided to, whenever June 29th does not fall on a Sunday, to take up the Annual Collection on the first Sunday after that date, and of course, this year, we are taking up the Collection on June 30th. To facilitate this Special Collection, I will ask the Sunday Mass Collectors to take-up a second collection immediately after the first has been completed. In order to avoid confusion, our Sunday First Collection will be for your financial support of this Parish; the Second Collection will be exclusively for Peter's Pence, and the proceeds from this Collection will be forwarded to Rome for the Pope to disperse, at his discretion, to the most needy and also as relief funds whenever and wherever emergencies such as earthquakes, droughts, flood, tsunami, et cetera, occur. Your generous support of this Annual Appeal will be appreciated.

Our first week of school vacation for parishioners has been incident-free to the best of my knowledge; so let's try to have an incident-free period in the second and final week of vacations too. For those who will be driving anywhere, please drive safely.

Tomorrow, Monday marks the beginning of a new financial year for Australians, so that also means that the current financial comes to an end today, and submission of Personal Income Tax Returns are due. Sorry to end on a glum note. May God bless you and your families throughout the week ahead.




SIGNS OF HOPE - PEOPLE OF FAITH


