Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 7th July 2024 - Year B

Dear Parishioners,

Four of our five Round 2, RCIA Candidates take a major step forward in their journey of faith today during our 9:30am Sunday Nundah Mass. Their names will be inscribed in the Book of the Elect. By inscribing their names, they transition from being identified as a Catechumen to a Candidate for Admission into the Church. Another transition point is achieved also because they move from the Catechumenate period of their preparation of their journey to the final phase which is referred to as the Period of Purification and Enlightenment. All five Candidates are now on the downhill run towards their reception into the Church on Sunday, August 25. I say downhill deliberately because for them, their Sponsors and the members of the Catechetical Team, the pace quickens somewhat as they will be called upon to be scrutinised before all at three Sunday Masses about their intentions and commitment, and to be presented with the Creed and Lord's Prayer during their weekly group meetings. A lot of this might seem like a lot of double-Dutch to many Parishioners, but I assure you that it is not. I thank you for your continued prayerful support for Sakiko Hirata, Jennifer van Iperen, Myles Payne, David Thompson and Felix Bonomini.

The mid-year school vacation comes to an end today (Sunday), and I thank the Lord that, to the best of my knowledge, none of our Parishioners have been involved in any major road incidences. Thank you to for your careful driving practices across the past fortnight.

The songs and stories concert recital by the singer-guitarist Peter Kearney, which he has called Signs of Hope - People of Faith, draws closer with every passing week. It is now only a fortnight away - Saturday, 20 July, commencing at 11:30am. Our Parish Care and Concern group have stepped forward and volunteered to cater for the interval meal. For more specific detail, I urge you to read the promo that has been included in this edition of the Parish Newsletter. For all who attend, it should be a useful two or so hours of our time. I hope to see you there.

You would be aware if you have been attending our Parish Sunday Masses of late, that towards the end of Mass, the Parish has been praying the Synod24 Prayer. The Brisbane Archdiocesan Synod has two sessions, one in September and one in October. The Synod and those who have been nominated to represent the Archdiocese (and these include a cross-representation of clergy and lay) have the responsible task of discerning, with the assistance of the Holy Spirit, the path forward for our local Church. Specifically, these delegates will discern how, in our Archdiocese, the decisions from the recent Australian Plenary Council will be implemented. As a Parish, we are honoured to supply one of the lay person delegates to this Synod; and that Parishioner is Gysell Mortimer. Congratulations Gysell, and know that our prayers and thoughts will be with you.

A final bit of feedback to Parishioners on our Parish Pastoral Council Elections. The Parish received a total of three nomination forms, with each form contributing two nominees for consideration. I should add that none of the nominees were selfnominations, so the Parish is now in the throes of enquiring with each of the six individuals nominated in order to ascertain whether they will or will not accept there nomination to serve on the Parish Pastoral Council. I hope that they will give favourable consideration to serving on the Council. Thank you to all Parishioners for your participation in this important task of recruiting people to represent you on the Council.

May the Lord bless you and your endeavours throughout the week ahead.


