Dear Parishioners,

During next weekend's Sunday Masses, all throughout the Archdiocese, the Annual Catholic Campaian will be conducted. The whole original goal of the Campaign was to rationalise and reduce the frequency and number of Archdiocesan Appeals. It has been in operation just over a decade now, beginning in 2013. And it has certainly succeeded in that goal. The Campaign has six major foci:

- 1. The Priests Foundation which offers financial support to the Archdiocese's retired and infirm priests.
- 2. Supporting the various ministries operated by **Centacare**.
- 3. Supporting the education of future priests in the Holy Spirit Provincial Seminary, Banyo.
- 4. Providing students of financially struggling families to receive a quality Catholic education via the Mary MacKillop Bursary Fund.
- 5. Assisting grassroot ministries within Parishes of the Archdiocese via the **Annual Grants Program.**
- 6. Contributing towards the operational expenses of the Archdiocese's premier retreat centre at Ormiston, the Santa Teresa Spirituality Centre.

I should point out that financial contributions towards the first four items are recognised as tax-deductible gifts; the latter two – the Annual Grants Program and the Santa Teresa Spirituality Centre - are deemed to be non-taxdeductible gifts.

During today's Masses, a Parish Finance Councillor will speak briefly about the Annual Catholic Campaign, and ask for your participation by coming prepared for next Sunday's Appeal. I would strongly suggest that you take home a 2024 Annual Catholic Campaign envelope with you today, and return your completed and sealed envelope at one of the Parish's Masses next Sunday. Thank you!

The Parish received good news from the Queensland Government's Community Sustainability Action (CSA) - Round 8 Community Heritage Grant Program, that our Parish's application for grant assistance for maintenance repairs to the terracotta roof tiles areas of the Corpus Christi Church was successful. This project has received funding support from the Queensland Government's Community Sustainability Action grant program. The funding support amounts to \$50,000. The Parish sincerely thanks the Queensland Government for its financial support. We anticipate that the Parish will complete the work within the next twelve months.

The Parish Office has been understaffed during the past week with two members - Debra Visser and Angela Greathead - testing positive to COVID. It is unfortunate that their absence coincided with my own absence in attending the Annual 2-Day Archdiocesan Clergy Convocation meeting. The Parish Office was completely closed on Tuesday. I offer my apologies to any Parishioners who may have been inconvenienced with either the unplanned Office closure on Tuesday, or in trying to make contact with the Office at other times. I pray that both ladies will be COVID-free again soon.

I had a number of Parishioners approach me after last Sunday's Masses enquiring about the name of the author and the titles of his trilogy that I referred to in my homily.

The author was Elie Wiesel, and his three books were titled Night (published 1956), Dawn (published 1960) and Day (published 1961). The three books were republished in 1962 as a single volume in 1962. The books are his telling of his internment in Auschwitz during WW2. The author was a Nobel Laurette.


