Welcome! The Catholic Church's mission is to offer people of all ages and backgrounds the opportunity to deepen their understanding and relationship with Jesus Christ.

Becoming Catholic involves a journey of faith, accompanied by the support of a parish community. This process is called Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, or RCIA. During the RCIA process you meet with others to share, reflect, pray, and learn more about the Catholic faith. There are ceremonies or 'rites' at each stage to signify the steps along the way.

We will begin our RCIA program with an introductory meeting for prospective RCIA Candidates (together with Catechists and Sponsors) in the Parish Centre's Father Martin Jordan Meeting Room, 136 Buckland Road, Nundah, at 10:00am on Saturday, 26 October 2024. This meeting is an essential prelude to the formal commencement of the RCIA Program in early November.

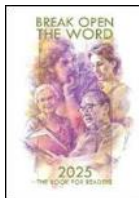

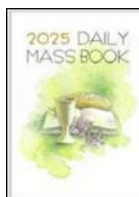
LITURGICAL ANNUALS FOR 2025

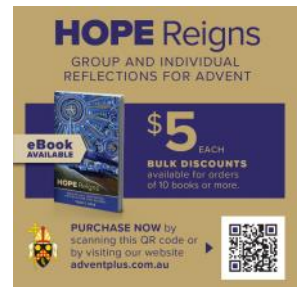

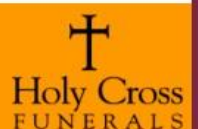
