Dear Parishioners.

The adage, 'No news is good news!' has held true for me from a health perspective. I reported in last weekend's Message that I hadn't heard back from any of my medicos concerning the tests and ultrasounds that I had undergone, because if anything had been detected in those procedures, I would have been immediately directed towards hospitalisation. Well, I was pleased to hear on Monday morning from the cardiologist that I had been referred to, that he had reviewed those tests and he declared them to be normal. I then visited him for our inaugural face-to-face meeting on Thursday afternoon, and he reaffirmed his earlier analysis, and after some discussion, he concluded that a new prescription drug that I had begun in early August had a side effect of lowering one's blood pressure, and it was not unusual for men taking that particular drug to have fainting episodes similar to mine. Under doctor's orders, that medication has been stopped and a substitute has been prescribed. My driving privileges have been restored so, from tomorrow, Monday, 28 October, all of the temporary changes to Masses and Confessions will cease and return to the normal schedules. So, to be more specific, Monday's morning Mass at Nundah will commence at 7:00am; Monday's Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will commence from 8:00am; Wednesday's 9:00am and Thursday's 6:30pm Banyo Masses will replace the temporary 9:00am Nundah Masses, and the 4:00pm-5:00pm reconciliation session will return to Banyo. I thank all Parishioners, again, for your patience, tolerance, understanding and prayers for my wellbeing whilst the mystery of the cause and treatment for the instances of dizziness and the fainting spell was being determined. And I send a big thankyou to Carmel Power for her offer to help by collecting me from home and transporting me to the Parish Centre from last Saturday's Nundah reconciliation session through to and including last Thursday morning. Her assistance was greatly appreciated by

I will report back to Parishioners with more specifics on our RCIA numbers in next weekend's Newsletter Message, after all, RCIA Programs, even if they involve but a few Parishioners, are a Parish-wide sponsored activity and worthy of your ongoing prayerful support.

I trust that the week ahead will be an exciting and fulfilling one, and may God bless you all!

We have had 37 families register to date. Thank you so much to these families for jumping on board! Many of you haven't yet signed up.








