Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe 24 November 2024 — Year B

Dear Parishioners,

On Friday, November 15, three men were ordained into the ministry of Deacon. They were **BJ Leonard Perrett** (Toowoomba), **Sean Woods** (Brisbane) and Sang Duc Bui (Brisbane). I had the pleasure of being invited and participating as a Concelebrant at these men's Ordinations. I did so, in part, as the Parish's official representative for Sean's Ordination. Of course, I did mention at our Sunday Masses for the preceding Sunday, how Sean Woods and his family have had a long association with the Corpus Christi, Nundah, community, and to prayerfully support him on this important day in his life. Tonight, being our 6:00pm Saturday Vigil Mass, Deacon Sean will assist me in the celebration of this Mass. I again offer our Parish's congratulations to Deacon Sean for his Diaconate Ordination, and we look forward in anticipation to his forthcoming Presbyteral Ordination around mid-2025. We pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to be a guiding light throughout his years of ordained ministry. I'm sure that there will an opportunity for individual Parishioners to express their own personal pride and joy to Sean on his entry into the Ordained Ministry either before or after this Mass. Deacon Sean's diaconate phase will be served in the Parish community of Coolangatta Tugun.

The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe is a major annual celebration in the life of the Church. The Feast marks the final Sunday of the liturgical year and the beginning of the final week (Week 34) of Ordinary Time. Next Sunday, the Church enters the Season of Advent as it prepares for the coming of the Lord at Christmas. The four weeks of Advent can be likened to the period of waiting and excited anticipation that mirrors a couple's experience as they await the birth of their child. One gets a sense of this through the particular focus that the four Sundays of Easter bring, for instance, the First Sunday of Advent emphasises Hope, the Second Sunday of Advent emphasises Peace, the Third Sunday of Advent emphasises Joy, and the Fourth and final Sunday of Advent emphasises Love.

On Sunday, during our 9:30am Mass in the Corpus Christi Church, three of the five men and women who have commenced their journey of inquiry and understanding in our third RCIA program during the 2024 year, will be officially accepted into the Order of Catechumens. The three people are: Lyndal Dashwood, David Gittins and Loren Cox. The Rite of Acceptance will occur after the Opening Prayer (The Collect) and before the Liturgy of the Word commences. The trio will each be presented with a Bible immediately following the Profession of Faith (The Nicene Creed). During this particular Mass only, the Prayers of the Faithful are omitted. Please continue to assist all six individuals who are completing the RCIA program, Lyndal Dashwood, David Gittins, and the husband and wife couples of Loren and Louisa Cox, Annabel and Sonny Beckman, with your prayers throughout their journeys.

I would draw Parishioners attention to the fact that this coming Thursday's Banyo 6:30pm Evening Mass is a cancellation because it will be replaced with a **10:30am Anointing Mass** in the same church. The Anointing Mass will be the final one for 2024. People who are elderly, infirm, or are suffering with severe medical conditions are all most welcome to attend and receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, and to have the affirming knowledge of the Lord's continuing protection and assistance being with them.

May the Lord continue to bless your endeavours throughout the coming week.

INVITATION TO A HEALING MASS


