The Baptism of The Lord 12th January, 2025 — Year C

Dear Parishioners,

Today's Feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the end of Christmastide. Tomorrow, Monday, is the first day in the new liturgical season of Ordinary Time. Tomorrow will be Monday, Week 1 of Ordinary Time, and the liturgical weekday cycle will be Year 1. In celebrating the Baptism of the Lord, we are also celebrating our own baptisms.

# A Reflection on Baptisms:

Baptism was not over and done with the day we were taken to the font. We are baptised by all that happens to us in life. We are baptised by **hardship**: in its turbulent waters we are purified of all that is false and useless. We are baptised by **suffering**: in its murky waters we grow in humility and compassion. We are baptised by **joy**: in its gurgling waters we experience the goodness of life. We are baptised by **love**: in its singing waters we blossom like flowers in the sun. Baptism is like a lifetime for this seed to grow and ripen.

Our Parish operations have again returned to normal operations: Parish Office business hours are 9:00am – 4:00pm (Monday to Friday); Weekday and Sunday Mass times, and Saturday Reconciliation times have also returned to their regular times. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament has partially returned to the 2024 timetable with the Corpus Christi Adoration returning to a 24-hour cycle on Mondays (8:00am – Tuesday 8:00am), but the Holy Trinity Adoration will conclude at 12 midnight on Tuesdays (from 8:00am – midnight, however, for this Tuesday only, Adoration will commence at 9:00am).

My second anniversary of serving as your Parish Priest almost passed without my noticing it. My first day as Parish Priest of Banyo Nundah Catholic Parish was on the Saturday of the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord, 2023. I would describe my two years of service to you, the People of God in this Parish, variously as being busy, intense, exciting, worrying, joyful, and eventful. Through it all, I have tried, with the assistance of our Parish staff, to provide a pastoral ministry that has assisted you to deepen your own faith journeys in the service of God and neighbour. I look forward in anticipation, with the help of the Lord, to serving you faithfully for many more years. Thank you for this honour and may God bless you all!

# For the right to an education.

For the right to an education. Let us pray for migrants, refugees and those affected by war, that their right to an education, which is necessary to build a better world, might always be respected.



#### **CATHOLIC THEOLOGY IN CONTEXT**

We invite you to prayerfully consider if God may be calling you to partake in this learning opportunity, particularly if you:

- Want to grow deeper in your love for God and others
- Are preparing for the ministries of lector, acolyte and catechist
- Want to share your faith with others
- Are a parish staff or volunteer who may not have engaged in formal theological study previously

This first module of four, Catholic Theology in Context, engages participants in the study and experience of God in the Catholic Tradition. The content and discussion will address questions such as, if God is infinite, is it even possible to know God? What reasons do we have for belief in the existence of God beyond religious frameworks? Within the Catholic understanding, how has God been revealed to humanity throughout history? What does it mean to know God in three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit? What is the word that God speaks to us in Christ and what is the Gospel? How do we live in relationship to God in the Church? And finally, what principles underpin Catholic Theology?

The module is not just intellectual, it is experiential, so be ready to understand God more deeply, and experience God personally.

The experience of the Catholic Foundations core modules are designed to engage both the **head** and the **heart**, to encourage participants to grow in knowledge and the lived experience of Catholic faith. This module is a 10-week intensive with an optional Archdiocesan Certificate awarded upon the completion of five responses to the set reflection questions.



#### Vanuatu Earthquake Appeal

Vanuatu has experienced two earthquakes within 24 hours impacting over 116,000 people and causing significant damage to buildings and infrastructure. The main hospital in Port Vila has sustained extensive damage and is overwhelmed by the mass causalities.

There are hundreds of people have been injured or trapped under rubble and at least 14 people deceased with the death toll expected to continue to rise. People remain fearful of further disaster, as Vanuatu is one of the most susceptible countries to natural disasters such as earthquakes, storm damage, flooding, and tsunamis.
