The Presentation of the Lord 2nd February, 2025 — Year C

Dear Parishioners,

Today, Sunday marks the fortieth day after the birth of Jesus, it is the day when Mary and Joseph presented their Son, Jesus Christ, in the Temple in Jerusalem. In presenting their Son, they were fulfilling the Mosaic Law of presenting their first-born son and consecrating him to the Lord.

Moved by the Holy Spirit, two very devout individuals were drawn to the Temple at the precise time of the Lord's presentation. They were Simeon, a very old man who had been promised that he would see the long awaited Messiah with his own eyes before his death, and the other was a very old widow and prophetess, Anna. Simeon's prayer, the *Nunc Dimittis*, 'Now, Master, you can let your servant go in peace, just as you promised; because my eyes have seen the salvation which you have prepared for all the nations to see, a light to enlighten the pagans and the glory of your people Israel,' is still prayed daily for those who pray The Night Prayer (Compline) of The Divine Office.

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord also has a liturgical element that is not always used by Parishes, given that many churches now use paraffin oil candles. This element is the blessing of the wax or paraffin candles that will be used in a particular church for the next twelve months. In this Parish, we have both candles systems in play; the Corpus Christi Church uses the traditional candles for its liturgical celebrations, and the Holy Trinity Church uses oil candles. So, at the commencement of the Saturday 6:00pm Vigil Mass, I will be bless Nundah's supply of candles. I did invite in last weekend's Parish Newsletter for Parishioners who would like their own candles (candles that they might light for use in their home and family prayer spaces) to be blessed, to bring them along with themselves. Hence, the alternate name of *Candlemas*.

Our Parish's RCIA Program recommences tomorrow night (Monday) after a short hiatus to enable those catechumens, their sponsors and catechists, who would like to take their families during the school holidays, off on a vacation. I would remind Parishioners that we have six adults currently seeking to become Catholics. There were a few other enquiries about the RCIA program in early December, but nothing has come to fruition from these initial enquiries at this stage. So, I would ask Parishioners to support the six adults (four of whom are catechumens i.e. non-baptised) as well as those enquirers who have deferred from beginning the RCIA Program, by calling in your prayers, that the Holy Spirit to protect and guide them during their spiritual journey towards becoming active members of our Church family.

Again, I pray, that the week ahead will be a blessed one for all of us. God bless!




JOIN THE GUIDES & WELCOMERS TEAM
