On this Sixth Sunday of Easter, we hear Jesus speak words of deep reassurance to His disciples: *"I will not leave you as orphans."* In these tender words, we are reminded of a beautiful truth at the heart of our faith—God's love is constant, faithful, and never distant. Even as Jesus prepares to leave, He promises the gift of the Holy Spirit, the gentle Advocate who dwells within us, guiding and strengthening us in love.
