Pentecost Sunday — Year A 24th May 2026

Dear Parishioners,

As a Parish, we are entering a very full and grace-filled period. I ask for your participation wherever you can — through your presence or, at the very least, your prayer. It all begins this weekend.

Today we celebrate the Church's birthday, **Pentecost**, followed in the next two weekends by our two patronal feasts: **Trinity Sunday** and **Corpus Christi**. Alongside these celebrations, our **First Holy Communion (FHC)** program is underway.

Our FHC children will receive the Sacrament on **Sunday, 14 June**, at either the **9:30am Nundah** or **5:00pm Banyo** Mass.

Immediately after FHC, we begin our second **RCIA Program** for 2026. As Bill Lawry used to say during the Channel 9 cricket broadcasts, *"It's all happening."*

Patronal Feast Day Volunteers

To ensure these celebrations run smoothly, we are again using **Flocknote** for volunteer sign-ups. This helps us prepare well in advance rather than scrambling at the last minute.

- **Trinity Sunday Multicultural Mass:** nominate your country of origin for the procession of flags.
- **Corpus Christi Street Procession:** there are **38 volunteer roles** to be filled.

Ideally, we would like the **Trinity Sunday flag procession list finalised this weekend**, and the **Corpus Christi volunteer roster completed by next weekend**. Your timely response will help everything run like clockwork.

RCIA 2026 – Call for Sponsors and Catechists

Our next RCIA preliminary meeting will be held at **9:00am on Saturday, 27 June**, in the **Parish Centre at Nundah**.

I am again seeking **Sponsors** and **Catechists** to accompany our new Candidates. Many parishioners have served beautifully in these roles over the past two years, and their lives — and the lives of our Candidates — have been enriched by the experience. I warmly welcome both returning helpers and those who may be discerning this ministry for the first time. Please speak with me before mid-June so I can form our catechetical team.
