The Most Holy Trinity — Year A 31st May 2026

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the first of our Parish Patronal Feast Days, the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**.

Our celebrations follow this order:

1. **Procession of National Flags** before the 7:30am Mass, honouring the rich multicultural life of our Parish. (Please note: this Procession is at the 7:30am Mass only.)
2. **Breakfast in Brady Hall** immediately after Mass. All are welcome.

This year we introduced a new sign-up method for the Flag Procession, inviting Parishioners to self-nominate via Flocknote. While participation is lower than in previous years, I have chosen not to distribute flags on the day, as doing so would undermine the purpose of establishing this new process. My hope is that, by bedding down this system now, we will be prepared for the 50th anniversary of Holy Trinity Church in 2027. I am grateful to those who have nominated and entered into the spirit of the celebration.

A similar Flocknote sign-up is being used for next Sunday's **Annual Corpus Christi Street Procession**, which steps off at 10:45am. This year's procession is especially significant as it is the second of our centenary events marking 100 years since the blessing and opening of Corpus Christi Church. Of the 38 roles required, only ten have been filled so far. With a week to go, I ask Parishioners to please consider volunteering before the sign-up closes at midday this Friday.

As we did last year, the **Nundah Church carpark will be closed to departing vehicles** until the procession has formed up and stepped off. This is a necessary safety measure. The assembly point for marchers will be the driveway in front of the Parish Centre, extending backwards towards the St Joseph's School playing field. For this event, marchers will be given priority over vehicles. I thank you for your patience and understanding.

Last Sunday I spoke about the importance of the Street Procession as an act of evangelization. Our public witness may touch hearts in ways we never see – awakening faith in those baptised but distant; or stirring curiosity in those yet to encounter Christ. In offering this witness, we fulfil our baptismal call to share the Good News, trusting that the Holy Spirit works powerfully through our simple acts of faith.

Let us make these twin Festival celebrations – **Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi** – joyful, prayerful and memorable for our whole Parish family.

May the Lord bless us abundantly as we celebrate.
