A Parish on the Journey Together

In this Sunday's Gospel from John (6:1–5), we see Jesus lift His eyes and notice the crowd coming toward Him. Before a single miracle takes place, Jesus **sees the people**—their hunger, their need, and their desire to be close to Him. This moment speaks deeply to the beauty of parish life. A parish is not just a building or a timetable of Masses; it is a gathering of people who come with their hopes, worries, joys, and questions, trusting that Christ will meet them there.

Our parish mirrors that hillside by the Sea of Galilee. We arrive carrying the ordinary realities of daily life—busy schedules, family responsibilities, uncertainty, and sometimes weariness. Yet, like the crowd in the Gospel, we come together because something draws us: a longing for nourishment beyond what the world alone can offer. In our worship, our conversations after Mass, and our service to one another, Christ continues to lift His eyes and see us.

Jesus asks Philip, "Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?" It is a question that resonates in our everyday lives. We often feel that what we have—our time, energy, patience, or faith—seems too small. Yet parish life teaches us that God works precisely through these small offerings. A kind word, a helping hand, a shared meal, or a moment of prayer can become more than we imagine when placed in Christ's hands.

As a parish on a shared journey of faith, we are invited to trust that Christ already knows what He will do. He asks us not to have all the answers, but to come, to stay, and to offer what we have.

May we continue to place our small offerings into the hands of Christ, trusting that He will nourish our parish, strengthen our faith, and guide us as we walk together on this journey. Amen.
