Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time — Year A 14th June 2026

Dear Parishioners,

In a recent message, I noted that our Parish was entering a particularly busy period. Since then, we have celebrated our twin patronal feasts of Trinity Sunday and Corpus Christi, and this weekend we celebrate another joyful milestone: First Holy Communion. With these celebrations concluding, our next focus will be the RCIA preliminary meeting on Saturday, 27 June at 9:00am in the Parish Centre.

This weekend, we congratulate the 40-odd children who will receive their First Holy Communion. We also thank their parents and guardians for their support and commitment throughout the preparation process. My sincere gratitude goes to our Parish staff — especially Rosemary Woods, our Sacramental Coordinator — for their care and dedication in preparing both the children and the liturgies. Well done to all involved.

Thank you also to all parishioners who have kept these children and their families in prayer.

First Holy Communion will be celebrated at the **9:30am and 5:00pm Sunday Masses**, and our First Communicants will have the special privilege of receiving Holy Communion ahead of the assembly on these occasions.

Looking ahead, I warmly invite those who are willing to assist with our upcoming RCIA program — as Sponsors or Catechists — to come forward. Many parishioners who have participated in recent years have found the experience deeply enriching for their own faith. I encourage both returning and new volunteers to consider this important ministry. Please speak with me if you feel called to help.

Finally, I would like to offer a few reflections on last Sunday's Corpus Christi Procession:

- We were blessed with beautiful weather.
- The Queensland Police Service (Hendra Station) provided excellent support to ensure a safe procession through Nundah Village.
- Around 250 people participated, representing all ages—a very encouraging turnout.
- While volunteer numbers were slightly fewer than in previous years, the event proceeded smoothly thanks to careful coordination, especially by our Head Marshal, Eva Cusack.
- Many participants remained for Adoration and Benediction, and others joined spiritually from the Fr Martin Jordan Meeting Room.
- Approximately 100 people gathered for the shared lunch afterwards, with many families and young children adding to the joy of the occasion.

One matter, however, requires attention. A small number of motorists exited the church car park as the procession was forming, despite clear instructions. This posed a serious safety risk. Thankfully, no harm was done, but I emphasise that, for everyone's safety, such directions must be followed. I trust we will do better together next year.

May the Lord continue to bless you abundantly in the week ahead.
