The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ — Year A 7th June 2026

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Patronal Feast Day for our Nundah Parish community: **Corpus Christi**. We mark this feast with our Annual Street Procession through the Nundah Village precinct – a moment of public witness to our faith in Jesus Christ, who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist for our redemption and reconciliation with the Father.

As we prepare to step out in faith together, please note the following arrangements:

1. **Form-up** will begin immediately after the 9:30am Mass, assembling in front of the Parish Centre and extending towards the St Joseph's School playing field, under the guidance of our March Marshalls, **Eva Cusack** and **Rinaldo Azevedo**.
2. **Lead group:** Altar Servers, lead banner carriers, the baldacchino carriers, myself and Deacon Kelemete, and the Holy Rosary Leaders.
3. **Following group:** remaining banner carriers and the wider body of the Procession.
4. We expect to **step-off around 10:45am**, accompanied by the Queensland Police Service. This year, we will remain strictly on the roadway, not the footpaths.
5. **Route:** Bage St → Boyd St → Sandgate Road → Chapel Street, returning via Bage Street. The walk will be leisurely and should take around 15 minutes.
6. The **Holy Rosary** will be prayed throughout the Procession.
7. On returning to the church, participants will enter ahead of me for a short period of **Eucharistic Adoration**, concluding with **Benediction at approximately 11:30am**.
8. Those unable to march are welcome to wait comfortably in the Parish Centre, where you can observe the Procession setting out and returning.
9. **Food and refreshments** will be available in the Fr Martin Jordan Meeting Room during and after the Procession.
10. As previously advised, the **Nundah Church carpark will remain closed to departing vehicles** until the Procession has stepped off. If you are attending the 9:30am Mass but not joining the march, please consider parking in the street to avoid delays.

May this year's Procession be a joyful and faith-filled witness for our whole Parish family.

Two brief announcements:

1. **First Holy Communion:** Next Sunday, children from our Parish will receive the Precious Body and Blood of Christ at the 9:30am Mass (Nundah) or 5:00pm Mass (Banyo). Please keep them and their families in your prayers.
2. **Recreation leave:** I will be away from **Monday to Friday** this week. Weekday Masses and Thursday evening Adoration/Benediction are cancelled during this time. Saturday's Baptisms and the Sacrament of Penance will proceed as usual.

May the Lord continue to shower you with his blessings.
